

### PAIGE

Paige is a semi-fitted skirt with a straight silhouette. The waist is finished with a facing with no separate waistband. The front and back feature princess seams, while the sides of the garment feature design lines at the hips. The decorative placket with grommets forms the lace-up front. The skirt fastens with an invisible zipper in the center back seam and is fully lined. Paige is above-knee length.

## SHOPPING LIST

To sew this skirt, choose suiting fabrics:

- soft, stable, medium or heavyweight, easily pressed and steamed, structured, non-stretch or with very little stretch
- the fiber content of the faux leather can include polyurethane on a woven or knit base.

**Recommended fabrics:** faux leather, faux suede.

For the lining, choose lining fabrics:

- soft, medium weight, opaque and with very little stretch
- the fabric should include elastane. The fiber content can include artificial fibers or blends.

The skirt in the photo is made of faux leather. The fabric is medium weight, easily pressed and steamed, soft, with very little stretch, with a knit base and polyurethane coating, the wrong side has a suede effect.

The fiber content is a blend of polyurethane and polyester. The fiber content of the lining is a blend of viscose and elastane.

- Lining fabric, 140 cm (55") wide, for all sizes, in meters/yards:

- Lightweight knit interfacing – 0.55 m (5/8 yd)
- Stitched bias-cut fusible stay tape – 1.3 m (1 3/8 yd)
- Paper-backed fusible web tape, 1cm (3/8") wide – 13.2 m (14 3/8")
- Paper-backed fusible web tape, 3cm (1 1/8") wide – 2.2 m (2 3/8")
- One invisible zipper, 20 cm (7 7/8") long, for all sizes in all heights
- Twenty-four grommets, 0.7–1 cm (1/4–3/8") in diameter
- Matching thread – 1 spool
- Topstitching thread – 2 spools

## TOOLS AND EQUIPMENT

- sewing machine
- invisible zipper foot
- teflon or walking foot for the sewing machine
- one-sided foot
- faux leather machine needles
- awl
- grommet setting tool

### STEP 1

Fully interface the following pieces:

- front waistband facing – 1 piece on fold
- back waistband facing – 2 pieces
- front facing – 2 pieces

Partially interface the following pieces:

- front band
- front central panel
- front top side panel
- back top side panel
- front bottom side panel
- back bottom side panel
- back central panel

Additionally, interface the top edges of the following pieces with bias-cut fusible stay tape:

- front band
- front facing
- front central panel
- front top side panel
- back top side panel
- back central panel



### STEP 2

Place the back central panels right sides together, aligning the centre back edges. Pin from the zipper notch down to the bottom edge of the pieces. Machine-stitch, backstitching at the beginning and end. Press the seam flat.
